





— U.S. (Q4=1.29)



# Texas and U.S. Unemployment Rate




# Texas Residential Permits and Mortgage Rate, 1990-2010



# Estimated Annual Net Migration to Texas, 2000-2009





# Percent of Migrants to Texas by Race and Ethnicity, 2000-2009





# Estimated Domestic Migration (2000-2008) as a Percentage of 2000 Population by County





# Estimated International Migration (2000-2008) as a Percentage of 2000 Population by County




# Texas Racial and Ethnic Composition, 2000 and 2010




# Projected Texas Population Pyramid by Race and Ethnicity, 2010



# Projected Texas Population Pyramids by Race and Ethnicity, 2010




# Total Population by County, 2010







# Percent Change of Total Population by County, 2000-2010



# Percent of Population Less Than 18 Years of Age Living Under Poverty During Past 12 Months by County, 2005-2009






# Percent of People Below Poverty in the Past 12 Months (for whom poverty status is determined) by Metro and Non-Metro Area and County, 2005-2009


# Percent of People Lacking Health Insurance Coverage by Metro and Non-Metro Area, 2009

Texas also had the highest uninsured rate of children, with 17.4%, or 1.28 million children lacking insurance.


# Physicians per 1,000 Population Aged 65 Years and Older by County, 2008








## Physician Rate Change, 2000-2010


# Physicians per 100,000 by Metro & Border Status of Counties, 2009



# Projected Population Growth in Texas, 2000-2040



# Projected Population by Texas Counties, 2040





## Percent 65 Years and Older






# Percent of Persons Aged 65 Years and Older by County, 2000 Census and 2040 Projected

2000 Count






# Projected Population Among Older Texans




# Projection of Ethnicity of Texas Population Aged 65 Years and Older, 2000 to 2040




# Projected Increase of Obesity in Texas by Ethnicity, 2006-2040
