










Industry Employment Projection Indices, Upper Rio Grande Region, 2003-2013






Estimated Annual Net Migration to Texas, 2000-2009











Estimated Domestic Migration (2000-2008) by County as a Percentage of 2000 Population












Texas Racial and Ethnic Composition, 2000 and 2010





Texas White (non-Hispanic) and Hispanic Populations by Age, 2010






Texas Population Pyramid by Race/Ethnicity, 2010









Texas Population Pyramid by White (non-Hispanic), 2010






Texas Population Pyramid by Race/Ethnicity, 2010







Total Population by County, 2010







Numeric Change of Total Population by County, 2000-2010




Percent Change of Total Population by County, 2000-2010






Numeric Change in Hispanic population by County, 2000-2010






Percent of Population That Is Foreign Born by County, 2005-2009




Median Household Income by County, 2005-2009






Change in Percent of Single Female Headed Households, 2000-2010




Change in Percent of Owner-Occupied Homes, 2000-2010





Projected Population Growth in Texas, 2000-2040




Projected Population Growth in Texas, 2000-2040






Projected Population by Texas Counties, 2040






Percent Projected Change of Total Population in Texas Counties, 2008-2040





Change in Median Age for Region 6, 7 & 10 Counties, 2000-2010






Percent of Persons Aged 65 Years and Older by County, 2000 Census and 2040 Projected




Physicians per 1,000 Population Aged 65 Years and Older by County, 2008






Race/Ethnic Composition by Education Level in the Labor Force (aged 25 years and more) for Texas, 2009








Projected Percent of Labor Force by Educational Attainment in Texas, 2000 and 2040




