



Total Population by County, 2010


Total Population



Population % Change, 2000 to 2010












Texas Racial and Ethnic Composition, 1990-2010




Bexar County Racial and Ethnic Composition, 1990-2010




San Antonio Racial and Ethnic Composition, 1990-2010





Projected Racial and Ethnic Population Percentages for Texas, 2000-2040




Projected Racial and Ethnic Population Percentages for Bexar County, 2000-2040




Texas Population Pyramids by Race/Ethnicity, 2010

Population Pyramid for Texas Non-Hispanic Whites, 2010




Population Pyramid for Texas Hispanics, 2010










Age Group as a Percentage of the Total Bexar County Population, 1990-2010




Percent Change in Population by Age Group, 2000-2010






Percent of Persons Aged 65 Years and Older in Texas Counties, 2000 Census and 2040 Projected








Projected Population Among Older Texans




Projected Population Among Seniors in Bexar County







Percent Educational Attainment for Population 25 and Over

Percent Educational Attainment by Race/Ethnicity, 2010









Projected Percent of Labor Force by Educational Attainment in Texas, 2000 and 2040










Projected Number of Adults with Diabetes by Race and Ethnicity, Texas, 2010-2040








